WorldSkills Australia Regional Competition Explained

The WorldSkills Australia Regional Competition is a challenge. A challenge to be the best in your skill area! Competitions aim to test your skills against those of your peers. It will inspire you to be the best you can be. Competing will show you how your skill levels rank against others in your industry.

Why should you compete?

WorldSkills competitions offer an incredible opportunity. Competitions allow you to measure your work performance against other people in your industry and region. Competition feedback can tell you a lot about yourself, in particular where you need extra training and what your strengths are. Results are a great way to get noticed at work and you may want to use the external feedback about your skills and abilities at your next work performance review.

Competition results will make you stand out! Giving it a go will demonstrate to current and future employers, the dedication you have towards your training and development.

How does the competition work?

At the competition you will be provided with a work area. Each work area in your category will be identical, meaning that each competitor will have the same materials, equipment and instructions. You will be given a competition project to complete over one day. You can bring your own tools according to a list provided in the Project Information package.

Your work will be assessed both during and at the end of the competition by a judging panel according to a prescribed marking system. Competition results will be announced as soon as possible and you will be presented with a certificate and a score sheet which details how you rated in each different skill area.

The competition day is scheduled for Thursday 15 September 2022 at MPA Skills Maylands Training Campus, 108 Caledonian Avenue in Maylands.

By entering the WorldSkills Australia Regional Painting & Decorating Competition you are also entering the Master Painters & Decorators Australia 2022 Painting Apprentice of the Year Competition.

What if I win?

You may be eligible to compete in the WorldSkills Australia National Competition if your category meets the WSA progression guidelines.

Am I eligible to enter?

REGIONAL COMPETITION

To be eligible to enter a Regional competition, you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Be undertaking an apprenticeship or traineeship
- Be undertaking studies towards a qualification at an RTO/TAFE
- Undertaken/completed qualification at a RTO/TAFE in the Regional Competition Cycle

There is no age criteria to enter the Regionals, however to be eligible to proceed to the National Championships, the National Age Ruling will apply.

NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

To be age eligible for the 2023 National Competition you must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident, born on or after 1 January 1999.

INTERNATIONAL AGE RULING

For international participation at the 46th WorldSkills International Competition in Lyon, France in 2024, competitors must be born on or after 1 January 2002.

Guidelines

1. All 2023 National Competition competitors must have competed in a 2022 Regional Competition
2. Regional committees will be responsible for nominating their most appropriate competitor for the National Competition
3. There is no guarantee of any pathway following the Regional or National Competition

All applicants must...

1. Either work, live or study in the region where they apply for entry into competition
2. Have the approval of their employer to participate in the Regional Competition
3. Abide by the rules of competition
